

## ARTIST SPOTLIGHT:

Xiang Shengmo (pronounced shyahng shuhng-moh) was a Chinese artist who lived a long time ago, in the 1600s. He came from a family of painters and scholars, so he grew up surrounded by books, brushes, and beautiful artwork. Even as a child, he loved painting and writing, and he practiced every day to get better. Xiang became known for painting peaceful landscapes with mountains, rivers, and trees. Instead of making his art look perfectly real, he used soft lines and gentle colors to show how the scenes felt, like quiet and calm places where you could rest your mind.

What made Xiang Shengmo really special was that he didn't just copy nature — he used his imagination and feelings to guide his brush. He was also very good at calligraphy, which is a special way of writing Chinese characters like art. Many people admired his unique style, and his paintings were treasured like poems on paper. Even though he lived hundreds of years ago, Xiang's art still helps us today to slow down and enjoy the beauty in the world around us.

## PA History: Harvest Traditions


Every autumn, when the leaves turned red and gold, families across Pennsylvania knew it was time for the harvest. For Native peoples like the Lenape, this meant gathering corn, beans, and squash—the "Three Sisters"—and celebrating with songs, dances, and feasts to give thanks for the earth's gifts.

Later, when European settlers arrived, Pennsylvania's farmlands filled with wheat, apples, and cornfields. Neighbors would gather for husking bees—big parties where everyone worked together to strip the husks off corn. Sometimes, if you found a red ear of corn, you could steal a kiss from someone you liked!

Apples were another favorite. Families and friends spent whole days cooking down apples in giant iron kettles, stirring and stirring until they became sweet, smooth apple butter. These "apple butter boils" were hard work, but children loved the taste and the fun of being with friends.

By the 1800s, harvest celebrations also appeared at Pennsylvania's county fairs. Farmers proudly displayed their biggest pumpkins, tastiest pies, and strongest livestock. Music, games, and rides made the fairs a highlight of the season.

Harvest time in Pennsylvania was more than just gathering food—it was about community, gratitude, and joy. Even today, when you see pumpkins on porches or smell apples baking, you're sharing in traditions that have been part of Pennsylvania for hundreds of years.

- Why do you think people wanted to celebrate after so much hard work in the fields?
- How were harvest traditions the same or different for Native peoples and settlers?
- Which harvest tradition would you most like to join in—corn husking, apple butter making, or a county fair?

- Small-Batch Apple Butter: Cook apples, cinnamon, and sugar in a slow cooker until smooth.
- Corn Husk Crafts: Make a simple doll or autumn decoration from dried corn husks.
- Harvest Journal: Write or draw three foods you enjoy in the fall.

- Plan a menu using seasonal foods like apples, squash, or bread.
- Add a fun harvest activity (pumpkin carving, baking, or music).
- End the day by sharing one thing everyone is thankful for.

## Pennsylvania Harvest Traditions


In the fall, Pennsylvania orchards are full of apples ready to pick.
