CHALC Graduation Conduct Guidelines

CHALC Graduation Mission Statement

While CHALC does not have any religious or philosophical requirement for a support group to obtain membership, What has brought support groups together is the love of homeschooling that we all share. The CHALC board has the goal of seeking unity that will result in a graduation that gives proper honor to Jesus the Christ. At CHALC we embrace the opportunity that CHALC Graduation gives us to bring everyone together. CHALC graduation is open to all members and non-members alike. So then, “We invite all to participate and to respect the goals of the organization.” CHALC reserves the right to deny participation to anyone who does not abide by the Graduation Agreement. Our by-laws support this by stating that all members are to “agree to abide by all standards and policies of the Coalition as established by the Board of Directors.” Additionally, all graduation participants are to refrain from engaging in any activity which may bring reproach on the corporation or home education.

All graduates to be eligible to take part in the CHALC graduation must comply with the following:

1. Treat everyone with respect and consideration.
2. Abide by the decisions of the CHALC Board and Grad Chair.
3. Recognize that CHALC is comprised of people from various backgrounds and will do their best to be respectful of each other.
4. Graduates are to attend as many of the graduation meetings as possible; with a minimum of 4 meetings.
5. Graduates are to be an active part of their subcommittee.
6. Graduates are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on homeschooling and CHALC.
7. Be mindful of the use of social media and communicate in a way that does not exclude other graduates.
8. Pay all fees for graduation in timely manner.



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Concerns regarding student conduct will be reviewed by the CHALC Graduation Leadership and, when appropriate, the CHALC Board. Depending on the nature and severity of the concern, consequences may include verbal or written warnings, parent conferences, restriction from specific graduation activities, removal from leadership responsibilities, loss of participation privileges, or removal from the graduation program. The goal of all corrective action is restoration, growth in maturity, and maintaining a positive experience for the entire graduating class.
